

Let's Make an Under the Sea Aquarium!

Supplies:

- 2 paper plates
- Paint, crayons, or colored pencils
- Construction or tissue paper for fish and plants
- Items for decorating such as: stickers, googly eyes, small shells, etc.
- Glue, tape and/or stapler
- Yarn or paper clip (for hanging the aquarium)
- Scissors



Directions:

1. Make a “viewing window” by cutting out the center circle of one paper plate.
2. Use yellow/orange/brown to paint or color the ocean floor of the second paper plate.
Paint or color the water blue.
3. Draw and cut fish and plants.
4. Cover the viewing area with plastic wrap that is at least a ¼ in. wider than the opening.
Tape in place.
5. Glue fish and plants to your painted plate.
6. What else might you add? Use your imagination! Goldfish crackers? Pebbles? Small shells? Whatever you like!
7. Tape or staple the top plate to the bottom plate.
8. Add a paper clip or yarn to the back of the plate for hanging.
