Let's Make an Under the Sea Aquarium!

Supplies:

- 2 paper plates
- Paint, crayons, or colored pencils
- Construction or tissue paper for fish and plants
- Items for decorating such as: stickers, googly eyes, small shells, etc.
- Glue, tape and/or stapler
- Yarn or paper clip (for hanging the aquarium)
- Scissors

Directions:

- 1. Make a "viewing window" by cutting out the center circle of one paper plate.
- 2. Use yellow/orange/brown to paint or color the ocean floor of the second paper plate.

 Paint or color the water blue.
- 3. Draw and cut fish and plants.
- 4. Cover the viewing area with plastic wrap that is at least a ¼ in. wider than the opening. Tape in place.
- 5. Glue fish and plants to your painted plate.
- 6. What else might you add? Use your imagination! Goldfish crackers? Pebbles? Small shells? Whatever you like!
- 7. Tape or staple the top plate to the bottom plate.
- 8. Add a paper clip or yarn to the back of the plate for hanging.
